Display

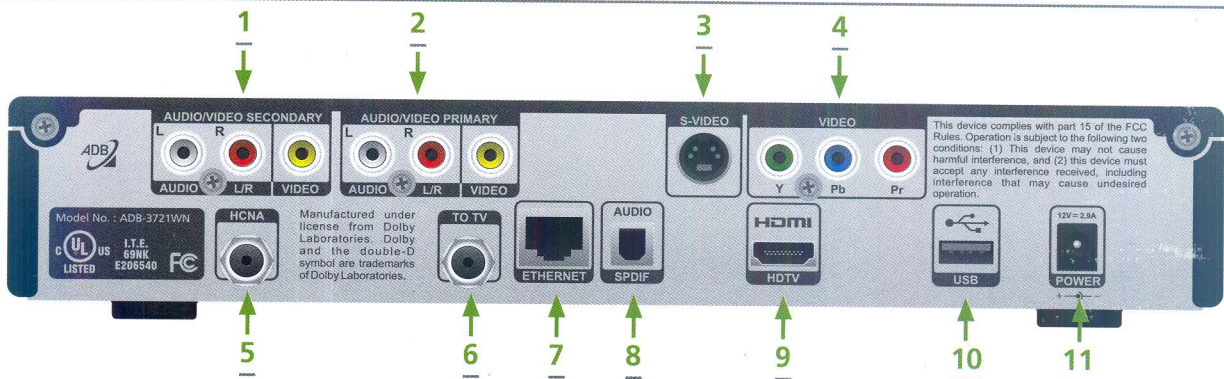
Display presents current time or a channel name.

LED indicators inform about the current status of the decoder.



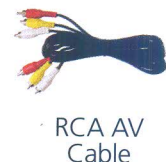
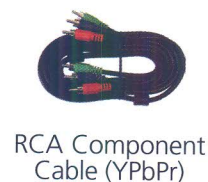
